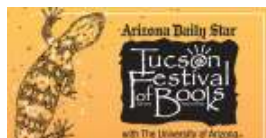
Chicago, Cleveland, Controversy, Civility

But for democracy to survive and thrive, we must learn to practice nonviolent means of engagement that are vigorous and intellectually rigorous rather than merely "nice." That includes embracing controversy constructively as a leadership and social skill.

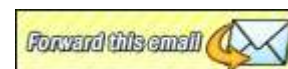
