



Once women "stand in their power and walk with intention," says Feldt, they can lead unlimited lives and reach parity from the boardroom to the bedroom for good—their own, and society's as well.

Gloria has a unique understanding of the confluence of the personal and the political in leadership and American culture. That's why People magazine calls her the "voice of experience." Author of four books, she teaches "Women, Power, and Leadership" at Arizona State University and consistently offers fresh insight, inspiration, and practical "power tools." These are takeaways that participants can instantly use as leadership skills, concrete solutions, and goal achievement plans.
